We are pleased to present our 2020 Annual Report to the Community.

2020 is behind us at last and we're looking back with pride at all that we were able to accomplish despite the challenges we all faced.

Although our building was closed for almost three months, we still circulated a large number of physical materials: 6,957 Adult Fiction & Nonfiction books, 8,243 Juvenile Fiction & Nonfiction books, 5,717 books on CD and DVDs, and 350 print magazines went out our doors. Patrons also took greater advantage of our **DOWNLOADABLES**:



AUDIOBOOKS

1,566 were borrowed; people love listening to them while driving & doing chores.



E-BOOKS

Handy to read on your smart phone, Kindle, laptop, or tablet, 2,045 e-books were enjoyed.



MAGAZINES & KANOPY MOVIES

Cutting down on household clutter, 606 magazines & 530 movies were viewed.

71 events (online or in-person) with **1,248** attendees.



Adults' Programs:

150 programs (online or in-person) with a total of **1,143** attendees.



Membership: We have a total of 1,614 patrons. 131 of them are new in 2020!

2020 was a year like no other! The COVID-19 Pandemic and the resulting shutdown forced us to close our doors for almost three months. Our building was empty but our plates were full...we got to work bringing you additional eResources and introduced virtual programming and online library card registration as well as curbside service. We reached out to many of our patrons via telephone and assisted the town in distributing face masks. While we were happy to be able to continue to serve our patrons during that long three months, the day that we were cleared to open the library doors and welcome our patrons back into the library was the happiest day of the year! Later, when the vaccine was introduced, we helped our patrons secure appointments and hosted McCarthy's Pharmacy Vaccine Clinics in our Community Room. Despite the challenges, we still had 13,057 people visit the Library & we circulated 26,092 items to our patrons and loaned 4,693 to Mid-Hudson Library System patrons! From the safety and comfort of their homes, patrons accessed 4,825 media items on their devices. They put those library cards to good use!
