We are pleased to present our 2023 Annual Report to the Community.

We're closing the book on 2023 and in the process we're looking back at another very successful year.

Our physical materials are still in high demand: patrons borrowed 9,925 Adult Fiction & Non-fiction books, 14,695 Juvenile Fiction & Nonfiction books, 3,432 books on CD and DVDs, and 543 print magazines. This is in addition to the many digital items that patrons took advantage of. Demand for these **DOWNLOADABLES** is always increasing:





Children's Programs: 151 events with 2,164 attendees.



Adults' Programs: 443 programs (online or inperson) with a total of 3,076 attendees.

The Stanford Free Library remains the center of our community and we are delighted to serve our neighbors in this way. During 2023, 25,251 people visited the Library & we circulated 35,604 items to our patrons and loaned another 5,162 to other Mid-Hudson Library System patrons! Of course, we are more than just books! You can also borrow ukuleles, pickleball paddles and balls, tennis rackets, board games, museum passes, and even a device that converts old slides and negatives to digital! Your library card might just be the most valuable thing in your wallet. It is good for your budget AND for the planet. We are happy to offer recycling service for used batteries and small electronics like old cell phones and tablets. Our quarterly "Repair Cafes" also help prevent waste. Bring your broken treasures to the next one (July 6th) and one of our talented volunteers will save them from the landfill! We held four Repair Cafes last year where 141 things were fixed for 98 patrons.

Your Stanford Free Library card gives you access to a vast array of online resources instantly, as well as our entire physical collection. But that's not all! Because we are part of the magnificent Mid-Hudson Library System, our patrons can request books and other materials from any of the 66 libraries in Dutchess, Columbia, Greene, Putnam, and Ulster counties that make up the MHLS. If you don't already have a library card you can now sign up for one by visiting us at stanfordlibrary.org. When you visit us online you have full access to ebooks, downloadable audiobooks, and magazines from four different library systems (thanks to new reciprocal lending agreements) via the Libby app, movies and documentaries using Kanopy, online courses through Universal Class, language learning via Transparent Language, or books, audiobooks, music, movies, tv shows, and comics through hoopla.
